Upstairs: Parish Center including the parish office

- 7 administrative and 5 ministerial parish employees
- SPRED training center with observation windows
- Staff offices & breakroom, 2 meeting rooms, storage, Catholic Charities counseling office, elevator access

GUILD HALL GYM

Downstairs: Gym, Home of the Knights

- Floating wooden floor installed in 2010
- Locker rooms, store rooms, office, kitchen with triple sink, 2 fridges, gas stove and pass-through window
- \$45,534.36 proceeds from laps run in Track-a-Thon

Upstairs: Music Suite, renovated 2017

- Classroom (Gr. 4-8) & for after-school music lessons
- Theory room, handbell room, piano lab and office
- Graded choral program beginning at age 6, affiliated with the Royal School of Church Music (RSCM)
