

- What was Jesus' mother's name? *(the Virgin) Mary (or Maria)*

Jesus is the *(only) Son* of God.

- In what town was Jesus born? Bethlehem

- How many wise men visited Baby Jesus? 3 *(the Bible doesn't say how many magi or wise men came, but 3 the traditional number since 3 gifts were given)*

- Who baptized Jesus? his cousin, John the Baptist

The Spirit led Jesus into the desert for 40 days and 40 nights.

Satan (or) the devil tempted Jesus in the wilderness, but Jesus resisted.

- At a wedding celebration, Jesus turned water into wine.

Jesus taught The Beatitudes during the Sermon on the Mount. *(It is also accurate that He taught the people!)*

How many disciples did Jesus gather?

- Jesus spoke with a Samaritan woman at a well.

The short stories that Jesus told the people to help teach them are called parables.

What did Jesus use to feed the multitude? bread and fish *(5 loaves and 2 fish)*

Jesus said that the kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed.

When Jesus' face shone like the sun and His clothes became white as light, it was known as the Transfiguration.

The disciples saw Jesus walk on water and were afraid.

- What animal was Jesus riding as he arrived in Jerusalem? donkey

- What did Jesus overturn in the temple? the tables of the money-changers *(where they were selling things to profit themselves in the house of God)*

At the Last Supper, Jesus spoke of the covenant of bread and wine as His body and blood.

- Jesus said He is the vine and we are the branches.

- What garden did Jesus pray in before He was arrested? Gethsemane, *on the Mount of Olives*

- What was Jesus crucified on? cross *(also accurate: the hill of Golgotha or Good Friday)*

Jesus rose from the tomb on the third day.

- Who was the first person to discover Jesus' empty tomb? Mary Magdalene or the 3 Marys
