Read Isaiah 11:6-9.

Which animals mentioned are...

What is the **natural relationship** between these pairs of animals?

Isaiah writes that “the wolf shall be a guest of the lamb” (11:6). Under **what conditions** might the lamb invite the wolf to dinner?
