## **HOLY FIRE Youth Code of Conduct**

Youth participants will:

- Respect other persons and/or property
- Attend all scheduled activities, arriving promptly, and staying for the entire event
- Project an image of Christian consideration, sensitivity, and respect to everyone and to the property around them through language, dress, and behavior
- Refrain from inappropriate touching, verbal harassment, bullying and mean-spirited activity
- Refrain from actions that could result in injury and/or damage to property
- Wear appropriate credentials in order to gain & maintain access to events & activities
- Keep their personal belongings with them at all times
- Be aware of noise levels in lobbies, hallways, and concourses
- Maintain the spirit of the event
- Report problems of any kind to a trusted adult
- Make appropriate gestures of praise, blessing, prayer and/or assistance to other participants

Youth participants will not:

- Possess weapons of any kind
- Purchase, possess, consume, or distribute alcohol or illegal drugs
- Engage in any form of sexual activity or peer sexual harassment
- Purchase, download, possess, or distribute pornography
- Touch another participant inappropriately or in a secluded area

No minor student may leave UIC Pavilion unaccompanied. In case of illness or a documented request for early dismissal, student must be picked up at the door by a parent/guardian.
