#### **This session's objectives** (normally taught over 2 sessions but condensed a bit this year):

- To encourage candidates to trust in God and recognize large and small challenges to their faith
- To introduce the practice of Eucharistic Adoration in preparation for "Holy Fire"
- To make candidates aware that **reading Scripture is an important part of being a Catholic Christian**: "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ" St. Jerome (feast day Sept. 30)
- To build greater skills and confidence with reading, proclaiming & looking up Scripture passages
- To inspire candidates with the **person &ministry of Jesus** as seen in the Gospels & personal prayer

#### This session's program: Time

- 1. Name-tag & <u>Bible label pick-up</u>; establish arrival ritual As students enter 0-5 min 6:45 as enter both days, candidates invited to <u>bless selves w/ holy water</u> (as when entering church) catechists determine when enough are present/settled at table to continue w/ icebreaker
- 2. **Icebreaker** (Track A intros selves w/ name, schl, At Tables/Groups 5 min 6:50 detail drawn from cup (skipped @ last class) or share journal pp. vii-viii (Track B!)
- 3. **Opening Prayer** (Act of Faith, top of p. 108 in textbook) Monica/Keenan 5 min 6:55
- 4. **Belief, Trust and Faith** using PowerPoint slides & video Monica/Keenan 10 min 7:00 Group reflection from slides & <u>Trust in God illustration video</u> (Trust Fall w/ "Jesus" & "Laura")
- 5. **Table/Pair Discussion on Trust** (4 Qs from slide deck) At Tables/Groups 5 min 7:10
- 6. **Prayer Meditation: Our Eyes Fixed on Jesus** led by Monica/Keenan 5-10 min 7:15 recall image from Trust Fall video: being face-to-face, keeping eyes on Jesus; trusting that he has your back even when human logic tells us this must be absurd (Track B should do part of song) prayer with "Turn Your Eyes" (Lauren Daigle) and diverse pictures of the face of Jesus can be prayed anytime with a smart phone & Google Image Search choose your own face of Jesus
- 7. **Meeting Jesus in the Eucharist: Seen and Unseen** Monica/Keenan 5 min 7:25 going to experience Eucharistic Adoration at Holy Fire -- quiet time to speak to Jesus face-to-face, in the form of the Bl. Sacrament, the same Body of Christ we receive at Mass, on display!
- 8. Two Adoration Videos: Atmosphere & Personal Witnesses Monica/Keenan 10 min 7:30
- 9. **Reading Scripture & Using the Bible** *Monica/Keenan* **0-5** min 7:40 review Bible basics (<u>divisions</u>, history, inspired Word, truth vs. fact); <u>how to locate passages</u> Jesus as Word incarnate (& St. Jerome quote) "proclaim" vs. "read" *Track B already know all?*
- 10. **Jesus Trivia: Toss-n-Tell Balls / "Go Jesus Fish!"** At Tables/Groups 5 min 7:45 Tables/groups test their ability to work together and recall other information about Jesus by using the toss-and-tell balls and/or playing the matching Q&A card game lay out questions as a trivia game each table/group gets 2 decks (1 blue, 1 brown) each blue card has a match in the brown deck match 12 blue cards with 12 brown cards by determining which questions go with which answers
- 11. **Breakout Session: Who is Jesus?** At Tables/Groups 20-25 min 7:50 recommend Track B work **in pairs or triads** on maybe 5-6 sets of passages (Pink & Red sets harder)
  - important to get 360° view of Jesus by thinking about his different actions
  - see attached page for "cheat sheet" of themes among passages for quick reference
  - each table/group receives a set of 3 passages relating to a theme of Jesus' life
  - reflection questions accompany the passages. Select a scribe to <u>take notes</u> about their answers and a <u>speaker</u> to report on what passages tell us about who Jesus is (<u>final Question</u>)
- 12. **Reporting on Breakout Session** *Reporting, facilitated by Monica/Keenan* 5 min 8:15 Speaker from each table/group shares response to final question from sheet
- 13. Homework & "Holy Fire" Reminders Monica/Keenan (other side of this page) 5 min 8:20
- 14. Closing Prayer Ritual with Blessing of the Senses Monica/Keenan 5 min 8:25
