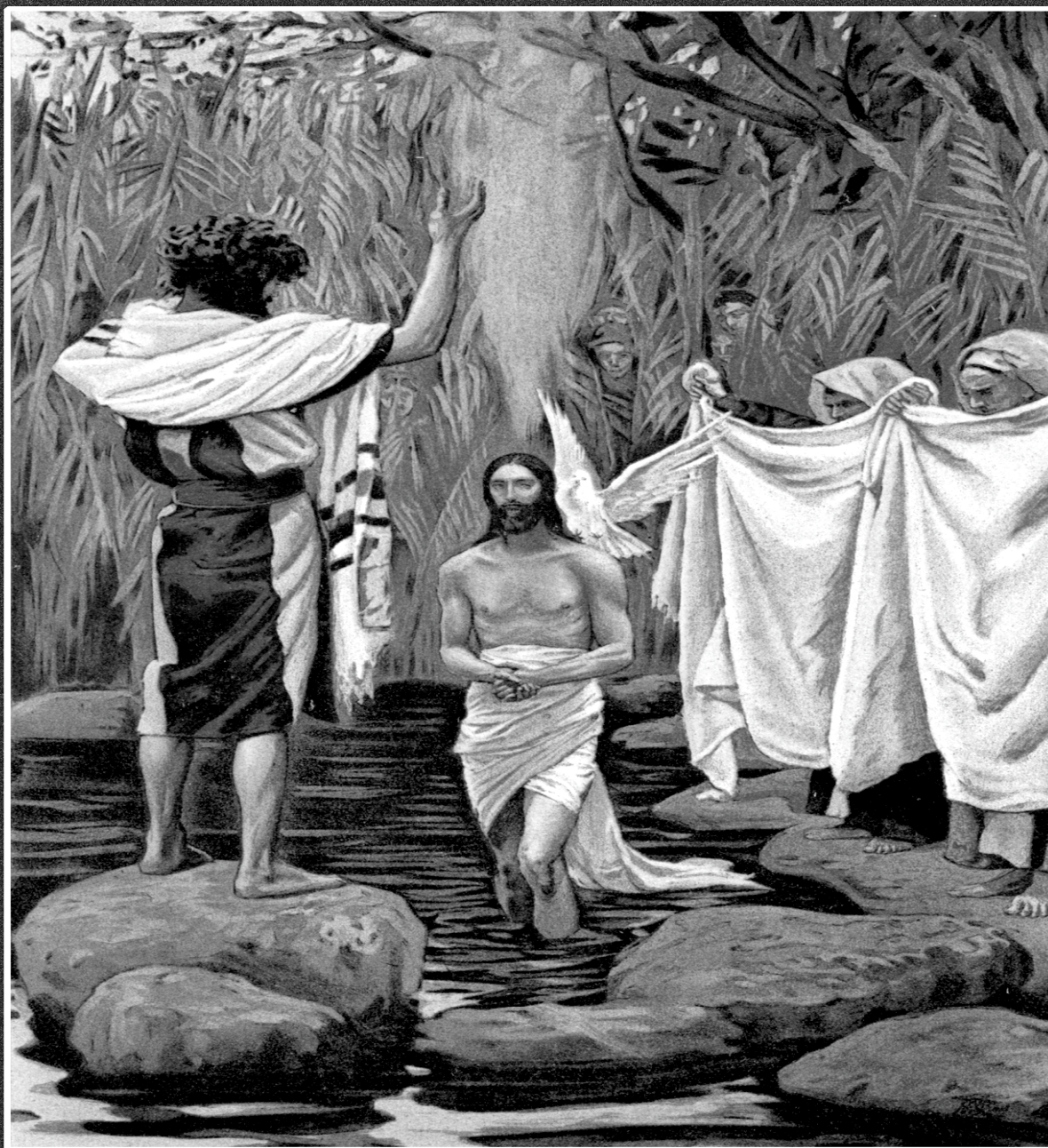

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The symbols and actions of baptism evolved around the experience of adults dying to old patterns of life and rising from the waters of baptism as new creations. As for newborn babies, at first it was desired to wait until the following Easter, when they could be baptized, anointed with chrism, and given a taste of the Eucharist in association with adults. The Church was always willing to baptize adults in emergency situations outside the Easter timetable, and in time, since infancy itself was a life-threatening situation, the baptism of babies became commonplace. As with the "emergency" adult baptisms, it was required that parents bring the child, as soon as health was recovered, to the bishop for the full menu of sacraments.

The very real fear of death for infants thus created a situation in which the three sacraments drifted apart from each other, and away from their original, adult celebration at Easter. Today, at last, we know a great deal about how our practices evolved. This knowledge is reshaping how we celebrate Easter, how we receive adult faith, and how we structure the faith journey of children.

CALENDARS- Perhaps you noticed that this year we didn't celebrate the Baptism of the Lord on the Sunday after Epiphany (today), but instead on last Monday, the day after Epiphany. Why the shift? It all has to do with regional calendars. Within certain general boundaries, every national conference of bishops is able to set its own liturgical calendar according to how it is felt to benefit the people in that region most. So, for example, the Epiphany of the Lord is celebrated January 6 on the Church's universal calendar. But the bishops of the United States decided that, for the benefit of the faithful, it would be better for Epiphany to be celebrated on a Sunday every year. So here in the States we see Epiphany's date vary from January 2 to January 8. The biggest problem this presents is that the Baptism of the Lord, which is normally celebrated on the Sunday after the Epiphany, would push back the whole liturgical calendar by a week on the years when the Sunday celebration of the Epiphany falls on January 7 or 8, putting the U.S. out of sync with the rest of the Catholic world at least until Lent. To avoid that scenario, the U. S. bishops decreed that in those years the Baptism of the Lord would fall on the Monday after Epiphany, leaving the rest of the calendar intact. -Copyright © J. S. EL CRISTO NEGRO DE ESQUIPULAS

Allá donde late el Corazón de América Central, a 10 kilómetros de Honduras y as 22 de la Republica de El Salvador, en el oriente de Guatemala, se levanta un hermoso y antiguo volcán ya apagado, con un nombre sonoro y decidor de tiempos antiguos: El Quetzaltepeque, que es el cerro del Quetzal, pájaro emblemático del alma guatemalteca. Hace algo más de 400 años atrás, la población que hacía poco se había asentado a los pies de ese cerro, y que llevaba el mismo nombre quiso tener una imagen del crucificado para poder venerar con ella el misterio de salvación realizado por Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, y pidieron que se tallara, en tamaño casi natural, un Cristo Crucificado. Para poder pagar su costo, todo el pueblo realizó durante dos años un trabajo comunitario. Un terreno de la comunidad fue dedicado a la plantación de algodón y en el trabajaron todos. Con lo cosechado se pagó el costo al tallista de la capital. Y la comunidad tuvo su Cristo.

Andando el tiempo, ese gran crucifijo fue trasladado a la vecina ciudad de Esquipulas, donde quedaría custodiado en el Santuario que es el corazón latiente de la religiosidad centro americano. Lo que es Guadalupe, con su devoción a la Virgen Morena y a San Juan Diego lo es Esquipulas con su Cristo Negro. Lo del color se debe a la madera en que esta tallado, y quizás el tiempo acumulado en estos 400 años.
