**PRAYER DURING LENT  
ACT OF CONTRITION**

My God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you. I detest all my sins, because of your just punishment, but most of all because they offend you, my God, who are all-good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of your grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasions of sin. Amen.

**THE SCRUTINIES**

Next Sunday, if your parish is blessed with catechumens (now called “elect” during Lent) who are preparing for baptism at the Easter Vigil, you will likely celebrate with them the first of three scrutinies. These are rites integral to final Lenten preparations made by the elect, and they are celebrated on three successive Sundays, starting with the Third Sunday of Lent. The Church tells us that the scrutinies are meant to uncover and heal all that is weak and sinful in the lives of the elect. During the week leading up to each celebration, the elect engage in prayerful preparation involving deep reflection on their own lives and the new life to which they are called. The rites themselves use a special form of intercessions specifically directed to the lives of the elect, and include a prayer of exorcism. It is essential that these rites be celebrated in the midst of the community, so that the elect experience the support of the parish members on this profound journey of faith. But it is equally important that the parish members witness the growing faith of the elect so they may be inspired by it for their Lenten journey of reflection on their own baptism in preparation for Easter.

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS ON FRIDAYS IN LENT**

Please join us in church each Friday in Lent to walk with Jesus in the Stations of the Cross. Stations will be held at 6:30 p.m. in English this Friday, March 3. Eucharistic Benediction is included in the service. Follow in the footsteps of Jesus on the Way of Sorrows through this meaningful Lenten devotion. Ponder and pray over the pains and sacrifices of modern life as you are moved by the trials Jesus faced on the cross. This is a great faith opportunity for adults or families of all ages to pray together in a timeless Catholic devotion.

**TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION**

Olive oil looms large in the vocabulary of baptism. There are other oils in the pantry closet, from grapeseed to safflower to canola, but only olives yield the proper meanings. Olives don't just happen; they are cultivated, nurtured, pruned, and fussed over; they are a sign of human and divine cooperation. Olives can thrive in poor soil, but they cannot survive without human ingenuity, planting shoots and pruning branches. They can't be popped from a tree and munched like apples: they are inedible without long curing; neither do they yield their oil to hand pressure alone, but only to huge stone mills. Abundant patience is needed as sediment sinks to the bottom of storage barrels and pure oil rises to the surface. Olive oil is a byproduct of peace: war keeps harvesters, planters, and pruners within city walls and turns millers into soldiers. To obtain oil from olives you need vast measures of hope, patience, faith, and ingenuity. Olive oil is a sign of God's bounty and the way we human beings collaborate with God to bring about impossibly wonderful results. It is creation at its finest. Some people give chocolate eggs for Easter; perhaps olive oil is a more appropriate gift!

**ALMSGIVING**

Giving alms has always been an important part of Lent. For many people, it means giving money to Catholic charities or some other good cause. But the concept of almsgiving goes much deeper. It is our response to the teachings of Jesus that encourage us to reach out to people in need—not just with our money—but with our time and our talents. Today we might call it 'stewardship'. Lent gives us the opportunity to cultivate a spirit of generosity. It gives us a chance to share what we have and who we are with other people. It puts us in communion with others and helps us understand that we are all members of the Body of Christ. Think carefully about how you will share your time, your talents and your treasure during Lent. Keep in mind the words of the Lord Jesus who himself said, "It is more blessed to give than to receive" (Acts 20:35).

### LOS ESCRUTINIOS

El próximo domingo, si su parroquia ha sido bendecida con catecúmenos (ahora llamados “elegidos” durante la Cuaresma) que se preparan para el bautismo en la Vigilia Pascual, probablemente celebrará con ellos el primero de los tres escrutinios. Son ritos que forman parte de la preparación final de la Cuaresma de los elegidos, y se celebran en tres domingos sucesivos, empezando por el tercer domingo de Cuaresma. La Iglesia nos dice que los escrutinios están destinados a descubrir y sanar todo lo que es débil y pecaminoso en la vida de los elegidos. Durante la semana que precede a cada celebración, los elegidos se dedican a una preparación orante que implica una profunda reflexión sobre su propia vida y la nueva vida a la que están llamados. Los ritos mismos utilizan una forma especial de intercesión dirigida específicamente a la vida de los elegidos, e incluyen una oración de exorcismo. Es esencial que estos ritos se celebren en medio de la comunidad, para que los elegidos experimenten el apoyo de los miembros de la parroquia en este profundo camino de fe. Pero es igualmente importante que los miembros de la parroquia sean testigos del crecimiento de la fe de los elegidos, para que puedan inspirarse en ella para su viaje cuaresmal de reflexión sobre su propio bautismo en preparación para la Pascua.
