GOSPEL MEDITATION

My dad was adopted as a baby. It's a big part of my family's story. His birth mother placed him in a Catholic orphanage not long after birth. A young couple longing for a baby strolled among the bassinets. My father, then only a few months old, looked at the husband and smiled. The man said, "That's my son." They took him home and the family grew. This moment of adoption was a wonderful truth they celebrated even when my dad was a young boy. They told him, "You're even more special than the other children, because we chose you to be our son." My dad's eyes well up with tears of gratitude whenever he tells the story, even eighty-three years later. What is your story? Do we think or act like unwanted orphans? Who do we believe ourselves to be? As we continue to ponder Jesus' resurrection, we hear him say to us this Sunday, **"I will not leave you orphans."** God doesn't leave us alone like spiritual orphans. The power that raised Jesus from the dead is the Holy Spirit, who is also called the Spirit of Adoption. He chooses us to be His children, to share God's life forever. He gives us a future filled with hope. We are not orphans anymore! This Easter, that's the story we should share with others. It's the true story we are living right now.





MAYO ES EL MES DE CONCIENTIZACIÓN SOBRE EL LUPUS

El Mes de Conciencia sobre el Lupus ocurre cada mes de mayo y celebramos este mes para contribuir al bienestar de la comunidad afectada. Esta enfermedad inflamatoria es causada cuando el sistema inmunológico ataca sus propios tejidos y afecta el bienestar general de la persona de muchas maneras. Este mes se trata de crear conciencia sobre su impacto en los aspectos físicos, emocionales y económicos de la vida de una persona. El color morado se ha asociado con la conciencia del lupus. Uno puede preguntarse ¿por qué morado específicamente? Eso es porque el morado es una combinación de la pasión del color rojo y la calma del color azul. Se piensa que el morado pacifica la mente y los nervios, eleva el espíritu y proporciona el coraje para luchar. En honor al mes de conciencia de Lupus, nuestro grupo local de apoyo a Lupus decoró los árboles frente a la Iglesia Reina de los Apóstoles y el Centro Parroquial con hermosas cintas moradas.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

En este VI Domingo de Pascua, el Señor nos pide ser coherentes en la fe. Es decir, si alguien dice y afirma que ama al Señor y no práctica lo que afirma, no le ama realmente. ¿Desea saber si ama al Señor como dice? Si cumple los mandamientos, va por buen camino, pero si no lo hace, se engaña usted mismo; aunque rece el rosario y novenas, sepa la Biblia de memoria y vaya a Misa con frecuencia. El Señor Jesús lo dice directo: *“Si ustedes me aman, guardarán mis mandamientos” (Juan 14,15)*. Muchos creyentes dicen cumplirlos, pero obran lo opuesto. Jesús insiste aún más con lo siguiente: *“Y yo rogaré al Padre y les dará otro Protector que permanecerá siempre con ustedes” (Juan 14,15-16)*. ¿Qué más podríamos desear? El Espíritu Santo siempre está con nosotros, desde nuestro bautismo. La aceptación y cumplimiento de los mandamientos es una realidad en la vida de fe. Sin embargo, Dios no obliga ese cumplimiento. Simplemente lo propone y cada persona decide si acepta el reto o no. El aceptar esta oferta, implica tratar de ser mejores cada día. Muchos se marginan solos, se apartan de la gracia y de la propuesta de salvación de Jesús. En esta Eucaristía, pidamos a Jesús que sepamos velar y practicar sus mandamientos con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo. Sin su ayuda fracasaremos, en cambio con Jesús, todo será posible. El secreto está en *“tratar a los demás como ustedes quieren que ellos los traten. En eso se resumen la ley y los profetas” (Mateo 7,12)*.
